- <u>Eligibility:</u> This event is open to all 2018-2019 certified USBC Youth members. All adult bowlers MUST be USBC Certified members and in good standings. If an adult is not presently a 2018-2019 USBC member, an associate membership can be purchased at the time of check in (\$25.00 which covers you for the 2018-19 bowling season) <u>Current USBC membership cards must be shown at check in.</u>
- 2. <u>Dates and Location</u>: The tournament will be held April 28<sup>th</sup> 2019 at Bowlero Watauga. Squad dates and times are listed on the front page.
- 3. <u>Entry Fee/Deadline Date</u>: A \$45.00 entry fee is required per doubles team (\$12.00 lineage, \$8.00 expenses, \$25.00 Scholarship Fee. The early registration deadline is Thursday, April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Entries postmarked after that date will have a \$5.00 late fee. Re-Entries will be allowed on a first-come, first served basis.
- 4. <u>Teams & Divisions:</u> Each doubles team must consist of (1) USBC youth bowler plus (1) USBC adult bowler. The USBC adult bowler is NOT required to be related to youth bowler. There is no age requirement for the adult bowler. There will be a separate Boys and Girls division in U12, U15 and U20. The age of the youth bowler as of August 1, 2018, will determine the division.
- 5. <u>On-Site Registration</u>: Will be allowed on a first-come, first served basis if space permits. With an entry fee of \$50.00
- 6. <u>Lane Assignments & Check In:</u> Lanes will be assigned by the order of entries received. Each team must check in at least 20 minutes prior to their assigned squad time to receive their lane assignments. Any bowler checking in late will receive zero (0) for any missed frames. Late bowlers may elect to reschedule to another available squad on a first-come, first served basis.
- 7. Format: Each doubles team will bowl four (4) Baker-Style games. Baker-Style games are where one bowler throws the first frame and their partner throws the next frame. The youth bowler will begin games one (1) and three (3); the adult bowler will begin games two (2) and four (4). Teams will bowl all four (4) games on the same pair of lanes. The lane condition will be a house pattern with no redressing of lanes between squads. This is a USBC certified Scratch Tournament.
- 8. <u>Scholarships:</u> The scholarships portion of the entry fee will be returned 100% with scholarships held in the USBC SMART Program in Arlington, TX. Scholarships will be awarded on a 1:5 ratio or major portion thereof in each division to the USBC youth bowlers only. A USBC youth bowler may receive multiple scholarship in this tournament; however, they may only receive one (1) scholarship with the same partner.
