4. If any participant is found ineligible under the rules of this tournament, the entire team will be disqualified.

5. All participants must check in with their coach 30 minutes prior to scheduled squad time. Substitutes must be reported 45 minutes prior to squad time, except in case of an emergency. Zero will be given for every frame missed by a bowler.

- 6. Individual handicap will be based on 90% of 220. See below for handicap and division breakdown:
- 7. Failure to use correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average, resulting in more handicap.
- 8. Teams must bowl according to entry line-up. NO CHANGES will be made except for substitution.
- 9. AWARDS All prize monies will go to Scholarship, at least on a 1 in 5 ratio. Scholarship amounts will be awarded based on 1 in 5 entries received. Scholarship to be given are Scratch, Handicap, each division boy and girl. The handicap all events winner will determine the City Champion, Boy and Girl in each division. Only one award per bowler for all events. Certificates will be given in Division 1 and 2 each place based on the payout ratio.
- 10. Dress Code: All participants and coaches must wear suitable attire for this NCTUSBC youth activity. Bowlers must wear, slacks, jeans, walking shorts or Capri pants. If your hands touch the flesh of your legs, the shorts are too short. No abbreviated tops will be allowed. No offensive shirts. No headgear of any kind except for medical.
- 11. NO entries will be accepted after midnight, February 7, 2020 and no entry money will be refunded unless schedule is full.
- 12. If you bowl Doubles, you MUST bowl Singles and if you bowl Singles, you MUST bowl Doubles.
- 13. Anything not covered in the rules will be governed by the USBC rules. Exceptions to the above rules will be resolved at the discretion of the tournament director. Note: A standing sheet showing averages of 9 games or more MUST be submitted with this entry for all participates using the date of participation.
