- The NCTUSBC Youth Open Championship Tournament is open to all USBC Youth members in good standings.
- All entrants will use their highest current USBC Standard average of 12 games or more as of January 1, 2021. If no current average, you will use your highest 9 game average as of date of participation. If no average, bowler will bowl scratch, using a 200 average.
- Multiple Team Entries: A bowler may participate in the team event as many times as they desire. If multiple entries no more than three members of the same team. Teams may consist of all boys, all girls or mixed. When a bowler competes, the first team event series will count toward the all events series. Multiple entries will be permitted in team event only.
- If any participant is found ineligible under the rules of this tournament, the entire team will be disqualified.
- All participants must check in with their coach 30 minutes prior to scheduled squad time. Substitutes must be reported 45 minutes prior to squad time, except in case of an emergency. Zero will be given for every frame missed by a bowler.
- Individual handicap will be based on 90% of 200. See below for handicap and division breakdown:
- Failure to use correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average, resulting in more handicap.
- Teams must bowl according to entry line-up. NO CHANGES will be made except for substitution.
- AWARDS** – All prize monies will go toward Scholarships. Scholarship amounts will be awarded based on 1 in 5 entries received. Scholarship to be given are Scratch, Handicap, each division boy and girl. The handicap all events winner will determine the City Champion, Boy and Girl in each division. Only one award per bowler for all events.
- Dress Code: All participants and coaches must wear suitable attire for this NCTUSBC youth activity. Bowlers must wear, slacks, jeans, walking shorts or Capri pants. If your hands touch the flesh of your legs, the shorts are too short. No abbreviated tops will be allowed. No offensive shirts. No headgear of any kind except for medical.
- NO** entries will be accepted after midnight, February 5, 2021 and no entry money will be refunded unless schedule is full.
- If you bowl Doubles, you MUST bowl Singles and if you bowl Singles, you MUST bowl Doubles.**
- Anything not covered in the rules will be governed by the USBC rules. Exceptions to the above rules will be resolved at the discretion of the tournament director.

Note: A standing sheet showing averages of 9 games or more MUST be submitted with this entry for all participates using the date of participation.

All entry forms MUST have coaches' signature and MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE YOUTH DIRECTOR ONLY
