## Lewis Ray Youth Bowler of the Year

Adam has been bowling for approximately 14 years. During these years, he would always strive to be the best he could be. This has proven to his advantage, as he became more and more confident with his game.

Adam has participated in many local tournaments such as the Teen Bowlers Circuit, the Youth City Tournaments, the City Youth-Adult Tournament. His most memorable local tournament was winning the 1st Annual Lone Star Youth Invitational Tournament at Plano Super Bowl in 2014.

At the age of 12, Adam had his first 11-in-a-row, a 297. He bowled his first 300 game at the age of 13. To date, Adam has rolled four 300 games. His highest series is an 802. His current high average is 225.

Adam was selected as the 2015 James Land Sportsmanship Award recipient by the Grand Prix Committee.

Adam was an active member of the Youth Bowling Program at Cowtown Bowling Palace and participated in the NCTUSBC Youth Travel League. He has participated in the USBC Junior Gold Tournaments in 2015 and 2016.

Once Adam entered high school, he wanted to organize and form a high school bowling team for his school. In his Freshman year at Chisholm Trail High School, he helped solicit students to join the Bowling Club. Even though the team did not materialize, he persisted on trying again in his Sophomore year. The Chisholm Trail High School bowling team, won Back-to-Back Regional Championships in 2015 and 2016. Adam was the driving force in keeping his team together. In fact, Adam's bowling team qualified the last three (3) years to participate in the Texas State High School Bowling Team Championships.

On an individual note, Adam qualified in his Junior and Senior years, to participate in the Texas State High School Bowling Singles Championships. In 2015, Adam was a Semi-Finalist. However, in 2016, Adam qualified 7th out of 64 competitors. In the bracket of the top 16, he never looked back. Adam bowled his fourth 300 in the second round of bracket play. Adam was undefeated in all his matches and was crowned the 2016 Texas High School Bowling Singles Champion.

Adam was selected for the Fort Worth South All District High School Bowling Team for the years of 2014, 2015, and 2016.

Adam graduated from Chisholm Trail High School with a GPA of 3.9. He was a member of the Chisholm Trail Chorale, Varsity Baseball, in addition to the High School Bowling Team. He was also selected for Academic All District 5-5A for baseball.
