Ron started bowling at the age of 6 at Hurst Bowl. This led to a lifelong passion for the sport. He worked at Burleson bowl during high school while bowling in the local youth leagues and travel leagues. After youth leagues Ron moved to the adult leagues where he served on the board of directors for Johnson County Bowling Assoc and later Ft Worth Bowling Assoc when Johnson County merged with Fort Worth. From 2003-2012 Ron served as the Burleson High Schools Boys and Girls Bowling Head

Coach. During his tenure he had 16 teams advance to Regionals and 12 teams advance to State.

Ron bowled in many tournaments over the years performing well. His list of achievements include:
